

In 1949, Walter Schwantes purchased Lynn Dairy and since then, the company has remained a family business. The company president position has only changed hands twice, once in 1956 and then again in 1985. In 1971, William W. Schwantes partnered with Frank Thomas to invest in the whey protein industry, which is now known as Lynn Proteins. Both Lynn Dairy and Lynn Proteins continue growing to this day.

Lynn Dairy originally processed 13,000 pounds of raw milk in 1949, and today this number has grown to 1,700,000 pounds of milk, daily. With the assistance of the company's master cheesemaker, Lynn Dairy produces around 170,000 pounds of cheese per day and has won numerous awards over the years, for both quality and flavor. At this time, Lynn Dairy offers twenty flavors of cheese, and with their constant innovation and creativity, further flavors are currently being developed. Lynn Dairy offers a line of dairy products, for both wholesale distribution and foodservice, in addition to specializing in custom-made cheese, aging, mail order, custom cutting and pre-pricing.

Lynn Dairy is a company who is passionate about what they do, and this is reflected in their mission statement which says, "Lynn Dairy & Lynn Proteins is a food processing company dedicated to manufacturing high quality cheese and whey products for our customers.
